During your time in Year 6 we will expect you to:

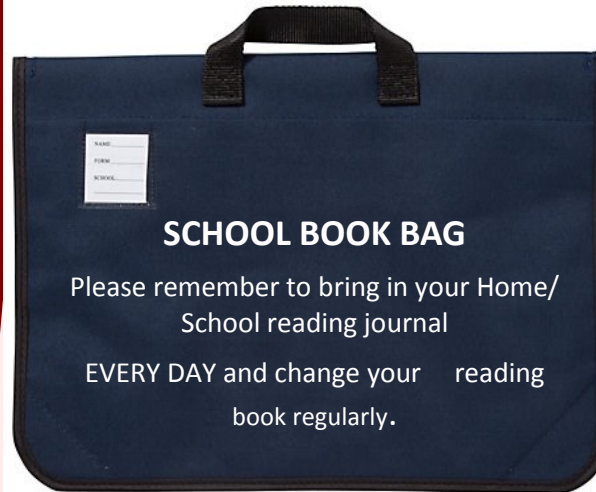
- ◆ Always put in 100% effort.
