Note:

- Children participate in swimming lessons during year 3 and 4 at Kobi Nazrul at our local swimming centre (York Hall). In the last 4 years, we have targeted sports premium funding to support the additional lessons in year 3 to improve swimming levels by the time they finish lessons in year 4. This was also a request from parents who really value swimming lessons at school – particularly those not confident enough in the water themselves.
- As the pandemic restricted swimming lessons for children, we have previously run catch up sessions in year 5 for the two cohorts that missed out.
- The results stated above are based on end of year 5 data. At the end of year 6, more children tell us that they can swim but this cannot be validated.
