During your time in Year 6, we will expect you to:

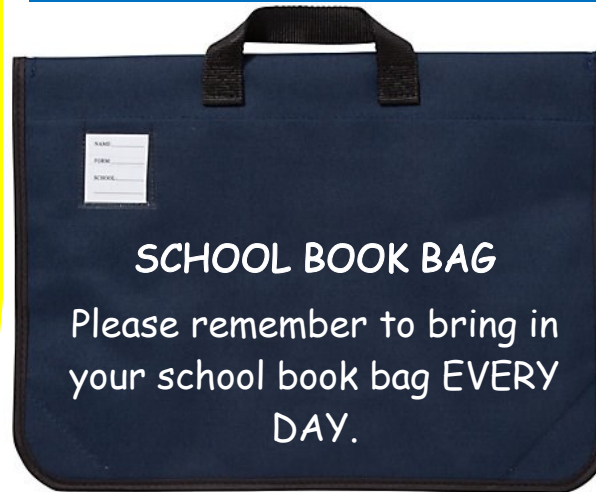
- ◆ Always put in 100% effort.

This term year 5 and 6's topic will be Benin



Science
